



## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BOOKINGS:**

- 1 Notice: 21 days' prior notice is required for bookings.
- 2 Maximum number of passengers and crew: The maximum number of people allowed on the vessel is 12, this includes the two Adult Group Leaders, plus 10 other people (minimum age 8 years).
- 3 Bookings: A non-returnable deposit of £25 to be submitted with completed and signed Booking Form. The balance of the hire charge is due as shown on our invoice to you, and should be forwarded to us as soon as possible. All uninsured losses and additional cleaning to be paid for.
- 4 Deposits: Are non-returnable - unless a booking has to be cancelled by us for reasons of mechanical repairs due to breakdowns etc., full deposits will be returned under these circumstances.  
This is the limit of our liability to you.
- 5 Hire Charges: As published separately.
- 6 Skipper: The Skipper has ultimate responsibility and authority for the overall safe working of the Out & About boat. Whilst on the boat groups must accept the Skippers decision at all times.
- 7 Adult Leaders: The Group's adult leaders are responsible for the behaviour, well being and safety of their passengers, under guidance from the Skipper.
- 8 Groups must fill in a log sheet for their cruise, these are provided on board.
- 9 Breakages / Damage: All breakages, loss of equipment and damage will have to be paid for in full.
- 10 Personal Property: The Bradford Out & About Barge Association cannot accept any liability for loss or damage to passengers' personal belongings. Groups should have adequate insurance cover for other risks relevant to all Youth Group journeys, outings and excursions.
- 11 Insurance Cover: Out & About has Third Party Liability insurance cover. All groups are advised to ensure that their members are adequately covered by suitable insurance.
- 12 Animals: No dogs or other pets allowed on the boat.

### **Skippers:**

If groups are unable to provide their own experienced Skipper please contact us as soon as possible. We may be able to arrange some training for you or, in some circumstances, we may be able to provide a suitably experienced person for you. In either case an additional charge may be made, please contact us to discuss your requirements.

### **Cleanliness and Hygiene:**

Cleaning materials and equipment are provided on the boat. Groups are expected to keep the boat clean and tidy, and before their departure ensure that it is as clean and tidy as they would wish to find it. The Association is run entirely by volunteers; we do not have paid staff to maintain the boat. If additional cleaning is required it is chargeable to the hirer.
